The fortune was seized mainly by special instruction by the secret police of Nuremberg-Fürth. However, a confiscation list for the fortune of the Dannenberg family has not been submitted here.

Sally Dannenberg, born 10.3.1878 and his wife, Emma, were deported in 1941 to Riga. At the end of November 1941 the new apartment furnishings of the above-named living at 20 Bucher Street on the first floor – 3 rooms, kitchen and bathroom were confiscated, the couple then arrived in Riga.

The person about to be deported should have handed in a list of his apartment furnishings at the police station.

I am asking for information as to whether anything is known at police headquarters concerning the use of these apartment furnishings. Since a report is to be made to the Finance Ministry, I am asking you for a reply as soon as possible.
