Humbly Sheweth

That Memorialist was born in Neuklenburg Schwan  
in Germany, is now Forty eight years of Age or thereabouts and is married.

That Memorialist has since the year one thousand  
eight hundred and fifty three resided in Great Britain and Ireland (excepting  
occasional visits to the Continent of Europe) and is at present with his wife  
and family residing at Killywood near Belfast and has carried on the  
business of a Merchant in the said towns of Dundee and Belfast and is  
an exporter of British Manufactures.

That Memorialist having settled permanently in the  
United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and intending to acquire  
property therein is desirous of obtaining all the rights and capacities of a  
natural born British Subject (except the capacity of being a Member of the  
Privy Council or a Member of either House of Parliament) and is willing to  
take and subscribe the Oath prescribed by the 7th & 8th Victoria Chap. 66.

Memorialist therefore Humbly prays  
that the Certificate of Naturalization prescribed  
by the said Act may be granted to your Memorialist  
extending to your Memorialist the rights and  
capacities of a natural born British Subject  
except the capacity of being a Member of  
Privy Council or a Member of either House of  
Parliament.

since the month of September in the year one thousand eight hundred  
and fifty three. That I have ever completed a continuous residence of  
three years within the said United Kingdom and that I intend to reside  
permanently therein. And I make the above sworn Declaration  
conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the provisions  
of an Act made and passed in the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> years of the reign of Her  
Majesty Queen Victoria the fourth for the suppression of voluntary  
and other general Oaths and substituting Declarations in lieu thereof.
