

JOHN D. OPPE

MONTREAL, Nov. 2 (Canadian Press)—John D. Oppe, who helped Guglielmo Marconi build his wireless station at Glace Bay, N. S., died here today in his home at the age of 76.

Born in London, Mr. Oppe came to Canada to organize the Marconi Wireless Telegraph Company of Canada. He was appointed a director of the company, which later was sold to United States interests and eventually developed into the Radio Corporation of America.

Mr. Oppe is survived by his widow and two sons.
