I, Carl Eichenberg, a NATURALIZED AND LOYAL CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, hereby apply to the Department of State, at Washington, for a passport for myself, accompanied by my wife, and minor children, as follows:

I solemnly swear that I was born at Adelesen, Province Hannover, Germany on or about the 18th day of January, 1864

that I emigrated to the United States, sailing on board of the Harmonia from Hamburg, Germany about Sept 14th 1887

that I resided about 27 1/2 years, uninterruptedly, in the United States, from 1887 to 1915.

at New Orleans, La., Galveston, Tex., and Dallas, Texas that I was naturalized as a citizen of the United States before the County Court of Galveston County at Galveston, Texas on January 23rd 1903.

as shown by the accompanying Certificate of Naturalization; that I am the IDENTICAL PERSON described in said Certificate; that I am domiciled in the United States, my permanent residence being at Galveston, in the State of Texas, where I follow the occupation of exporter; that I am about to go abroad temporarily, and intend to return to the United States within one year with the purpose of residing and performing the duties of citizenship therein; and that I desire a passport for use in visiting the countries hereinafter named for the following purpose:

Denmark, Norway, Sweden, Germany, England, France, Holland, Belgium, Italy, Switzerland, Greece, Britain and Ireland. Commercial business, and possibly to bring my son home from Germany.

OATH OF ALLEGIANCE.

Further, I do solemnly swear that I will support and defend the Constitution of the United States against all enemies, foreign and domestic; that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same; and that I take this obligation freely, without any mental reservation or purpose of evasion: So help me God.
