

The original and each copy of an application for a passport must have attached to it a copy of the applicant's photograph. A loose signed photograph of the applicant must accompany the application. The photographs must be on this paper, should have a light background, and be not over three inches in size.

As this blank must be promptly filled out. The legal fee of \$1.00, in currency or postal money order, and the applicant's certificate of naturalization must accompany the application. The fees should be carefully read before making the application to the Department of State, Division of Passport Control, Washington, D. C.

Eichenberg (Name) was born in Adelebsen and is now residing at deceased; that I emigrated to the United States, sailing from Hamburg, by about Sept. 4th, 1897; that I resided 36-37 years, uninterruptedly, in the United States, from 1897 to 1924 at Galveston Texas; that I was naturalized as a citizen of the United States before the Court of Galveston at Galveston, Texas on April 23, 1903, as shown by the Certificate of Naturalization presented herewith; that I am the law-abiding citizen described in said Certificate and that I have resided outside the United States since my naturalization in the following places for the following periods:
