The original and each copy of an application for a passport must have attached to it a copy of the applicant's photograph. A loose signed photograph of the applicant must accompany the application. The photographs must be on thin paper, should have a light background, and be not over three inches in size.

This blank must be completely filled out. The legal fee of one dollar in currency or postal money order, and the certificate of naturalization of the person through whom citizenship is claimed must accompany the application. The rules should be carefully read before mailing the application to the Department of State, Division of Passport Control, Washington, D. C.

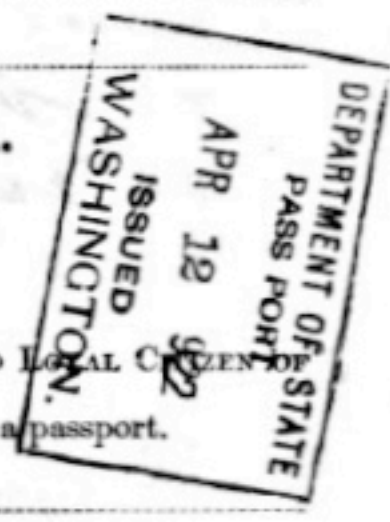

I, Eda R. Eichenberg, a NATURALIZED AND LEGAL CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, hereby apply to the Department of State, at Washington, for a passport.

I solemnly swear that I was born at Leeds, England on or about the 3rd day of July, 1877 that my husband Carl Eichenberg was born in Germany that he emigrated to the United States, sailing on board the S.S. Harmonia from Hamburg, G on or about Sept. 4th, 1887 that he resided 34 1/2 years, uninterruptedly, in the United States, from 1894 to 1922 at Galveston, Texas; that he was naturalized as a citizen of the United States before the County Court of Galveston, Tex at Galveston, Texas, on Jan. 23rd, 1903 as shown by the accompanying Certificate of Naturalization; that I am the wife of the person described in said Certificate; that I have resided in the United States, uninterruptedly, for 24 years, from 1898 to 1922 at Galveston, Tex; that I am domiciled in the United States, my permanent residence being at Galveston, Tex, in the State of Texas, where I follow the occupation of house wife My last passport was obtained from Department of State on 19th, 1916, and was cancelled on return in 1917

I am about to go abroad temporarily; and intend to return to the United States within 6 months with the purpose of residing and performing the duties of citizenship therein; and that I desire a passport for use in visiting the countries hereinafter named for the following purpose:
