

Ahubi

The name of Joshua Piza's grandmother was Luna Ahubi. We have not been able to find a record of any notable "Ahubi", but in the Jewish Encyclopedia there is an entry about one Ben Meir Ahub (or Ibn Muhajar Ahub) who lived in the XII Century. He was a Spanish-Arabian poet. In some early sources he is spoken of as Oheb. This name was a very familiar one in the West Indies.
