The designation given in Theresienstadt to the people arriving in two reserved cars from Berlin, Anhalter Station, was "I/50", which means that 50 transports had already left the capital of the Reich for Bohemia since 2nd June 1942. The RSHA had originally - after the two transports from Cologne of the 15th and 27th July 1942 - applied for a third special train for 1000 persons from Cologne-Falk to Theresienstadt, and this had been assigned the number "Da 526" for the schedules program of the 8th August 1942. However this journey was soon cancelled again by the Gestapo.
