This transport, which was assigned the identification "VI/2" at Theresienstadt, included at least 18 persons from Lübeck, 7 from Kiel, 5 from Uelzen and 2 from Rendsburg. There were others who had arrived from various parts of the Reich, such as Bützow in Mecklenburg and Schniebinchen in Brandenburg, as well as Rostock, Regensburg and Heidelberg. By the autumn of 1942, 180 of them had been transferred by several transports to Treblinka. At the beginning of 1943 another 33 persons arrived in Auschwitz and a further 124 in the course of 1944. 93 Persons from this transport survived the Second World War.
