A total of 2007 Jews were deported from the area of the Düsseldorf Gestapo HQ to Theresienstadt in 8 transports – 3 of these being individual transports. 114 Persons survived. The train composition on 21st July 1942 consisted of 20 third class passenger cars which had presumably arrived on 20th July 1942 at Derendorf as the empty train "Da 1069" from Auschwitz. The Düsseldorf transport had the State Railways number "Da 70" and in Theresienstadt was assigned the identification "VII/1". The transport included at least 300 persons from Düsseldorf, 268 from Essen, 224 from Wuppertal, 51 from Mülheim-on-the-Ruhr, 12 from Remscheid, 6 from Solingen and 3 from Harringen. In September and October 1942, 318 persons from this transport were transferred to Treblinka. In the spring of 1943, 19 persons, and in the course of 1944, a further 147 arrived in Auschwitz. There were 60 survivors.
