The third "large" transport of the aged out of Berlin was given number "Da 523" by the State Railways. It carried 942 persons from Berlin and 79 from its environs, among them people from Brandenburg (Havel), Herzfelde, Luckenwalde, Potsdam and Rathenow as well as 13 persons from the Radinkendorf Jewish labour camp. The designation of the transport in Theresienstadt was "I/71". 72 Participants survived. The train has occasionally been recorded with the erroneous date 14th October 1942. The last, fourth, "large" transport left Berlin only on the 17th March 1943. Meanwhile, however, numerous "small" transports of 100 deportees each were run from Berlin to Theresienstadt.
