The "28th Transport to the East" from Berlin once again included persons from the Jewish Hospital (Nursing Home) at 17 Auguststrasse as well as from the Jewish Hospital in the Wedding Municipal District at 2-4, Iranischestrasse. The train, carrying State Railways number "Da 15", was originally scheduled to leave Berlin-Moabit earlier, on 2nd February 1943 at 17:20 and to arrive in Auschwitz on the next day at 10:48, but in fact it departed one day later. After a "selection" on the old "Jews' ramp" at Auschwitz freight station, 181 men and 106 women were detained in the camp as prisoners; the remaining people were killed in the old gas-chambers ("the Bunkers").

The construction works on the large "Crematorium II" and a big gas chamber in Birkenau were largely completed only on the 15th February 1943 and on "Crematorium V" and a big gas-chamber, only on the 28th February 1943. Their completion was first followed by a "testing" phase.
