The "55<sup>th</sup> Transport to the East" out of Berlin comprised 31 persons, of whom 19 had existed illegally, and one woman who had fled to the Netherlands and had been seized in Amsterdam. After a "selection" on arrival at Auschwitz, 10 men and 6 women were registered as prisoners and included people from other cities. Four survivors are known. The other deportees of the transport were killed in the camp.

On the 22<sup>nd</sup> July 1944, Maidanek Camp in Lublin was liberated by the Red Army.
