Ruth Chotzen (b. 1922) of Berlin, one of the deportees on transport "Eo" from Theresienstadt to Auschwitz, later recalled that passenger cars had been used. Following a "selection" 191 women and several dozens of men from this "large" transport were interned in the "transit camp". Of these 111 are known to have survived. On the same day, a "large" transport of Jews arrived at Birkenau from the Adriatic port of Trieste.
