According to the registration at Auschwitz, the second Theresienstadt transport, "Ea" of the 16th May 1944 brought 2447 souls: 576 men and boys as well as 1871 women and girls. Out of the roughly 7,500 deportees on the three May 1944 transports from Theresienstadt, some 3,000 to 3,500 were, after the 9th July 1944, distributed out of Birkenau as forced laborers to other labor camps in the German Reich. On 11/12 July 1944, the remaining 4,000 to 4,500 people were led to the gas-chambers in Birkenau.
