CORONER'S INQUEST

An inquest was held concerning the death of Mr. Charles William Huxtable, aged 19, of Dominion Road, who met with an accident on Christmas Eve, the motor car in which he was a passenger being capsized in Harbour Street, Ponsonby. This road is a very dangerous one, especially at night, one side being lower than the other—some fifteen feet—where the car upset. After hearing the evidence, the coroner returned a verdict that death was due to injuries received through a motor car accidentally overturning and crushing deceased.
