

The original and each copy of an application for a passport must have attached to it a copy of the photograph of the applicant... The photographs must be on thin paper, should have a light background, and be not over three inches in size.

27-This blank must be completely filled out. The legal fee of one dollar, in currency or postal money order, and the certificate of naturalization of the person through whom citizenship is claimed must accompany the application.

I solemnly swear that I was born at St. Thomas, D.W.I. on or about the 7th day of June, 1868, that my father, Henry P. Mendes, was born in Birmingham, that he emigrated to the United States, sailing on board the Liverpool on or about January, 1877, that he resided 43 years, uninterruptedly, in the United States, from 1877 to 1920 at N.Y. City, N.Y.; that he was naturalized as a citizen of the United States before the Superior Court of the City of New York at N.Y. City, N.Y., on Dec. 15, 1888 as shown by the accompanying Certificate of Naturalization; that I am the wife of the person described in said Certificate; that I have resided in the United States, uninterruptedly, for about 39 years, from 1881 to 1920, at N.Y. City; that I am domiciled in the United States, my permanent residence being at N.Y. City, in the State of N.Y., where I follow the occupation of ... My last passport was obtained from ... and was I have never had a passport

I am about to go abroad temporarily; and intend to return to the United States within ... months with the purpose of residing and performing the duties of citizenship therein; and that I desire a passport for use in visiting the countries hereinafter named for the following purpose: England, France, Italy, Egypt, Portugal, Spain, Switzerland, Palestine, Azores, Gibraltar ... I intend to leave the United States from the port of New York sailing on board the unknown on July 20, 1920.
