

## HOME PURCHASE AGREEMENT

The following Home Purchase Agreement has been concluded between the Reich Union of Jews in Germany, and the married couple Gabriel Markus Israel Nathansen and Lea Sara Nathansen nee Knoller, legally represented by\_\_\_\_\_:

1. a) The married couple, Gabriel Markus Israel Nathansen and Lea Sara Nathansen nee Knoller, agree to the following:

Because the Reich Union is obliged to provide financing for all those who are communally resettled (in Theresienstadt), including those in need of aid, it is the duty of all those who have been chosen for communal resettlement, and who have means at their disposal, not only to cover the costs of their own resettlement through the purchase agreement which they conclude with the Reich Union, but in addition, insofar as possible, to provide the means for assisting those in need of aid.

- b) The married couple Nathansen purchases its place in the communal resettlement program, as of September 1942, with its contribution of 200 RM (in words: two hundred Reichsmarks).

2. The purchase amount will be paid as follows:

- a) in cash: 200 RM

- b) by means of the conveyance of -----, which is accomplished by the attached document.

3. Only those items which have been approved by the relevant authorities may be brought into the communal resettlement program.

4. In concluding the agreement, the obligation is assumed to provide the partner/s to the agreement with shelter and food for life; to wash their laundry; and to provide them when necessary with medical care, medicines, and hospitalization.

b) The right of resettlement elsewhere is reserved.

c) The partner/s to the contract may not infer any claim arising from an alteration of the current form of resettlement.

5. In the event of a physical or mental disablement of one or both of the partners to the agreement, which renders it impossible for him/her to remain in the communal resettlement program, and causes resettlement elsewhere to appear indicated, the Reich Union shall have the right to take appropriate measures. The same right shall apply in cases of repeated serious violations of the rules of order of the communal resettlement program.

6. a) The purchase amount, once paid, becomes the property of the Reich Union.

b) In the case of the death of one of the partners to the purchase agreement, or in the case of the cancellation of the agreement due to some other cause, there shall be no legal claim to a refund of the purchase amount.
