On the 13th July 1942, 18 Jews were once again departed from Chemnitz, possibly in connection with another, previously mentioned, transport from South Germany; they could not be assigned with certainty to any other transport. In the absence of other evidence the destination of their deportation was assumed to be "Auschwitz". Some 160 to 170 Jews may be assumed to have left Leipzig with this transport.
